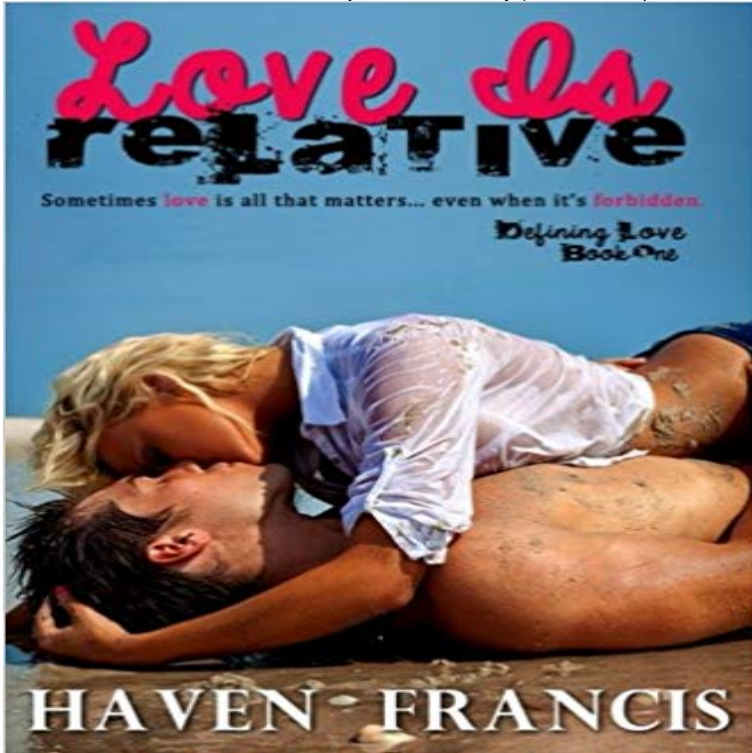


Love Is Relative (Defining Love, Book One) (Volume 1)
