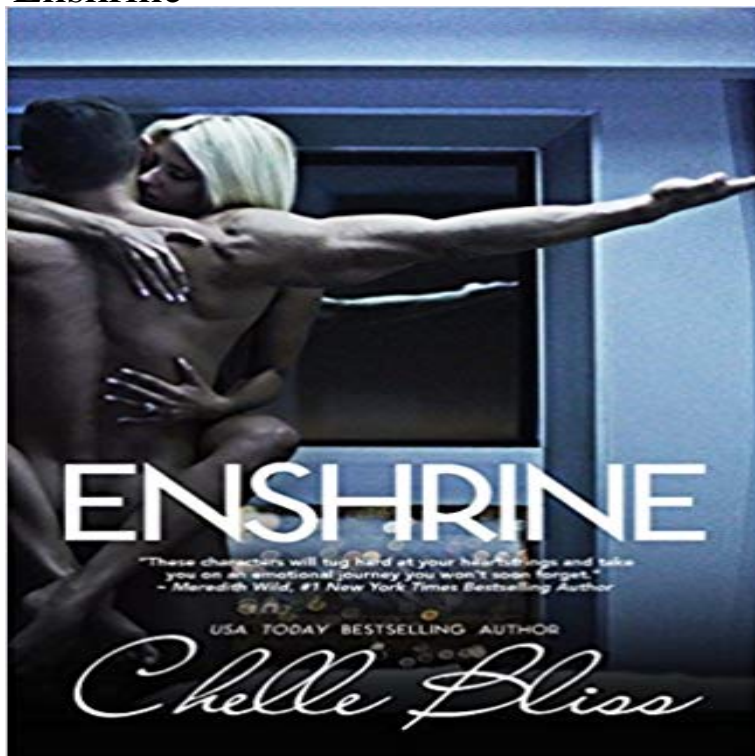


Enshrine
