There are no Christian references or spiritual themes. *What is a novelette? A novelette is shorter than a novella and longer than a short story--usually between 8,000 and 17,000 words long. Novelettes, like novellas, are intended to be completely self-contained stand-alone stories--although many authors are pushing the envelope on what qualifies as self-contained, so the term may be evolving. Many authors skip the novelette designation and call prose of this length a long short story. The term novella and novelette are also sometimes used interchangeably. Still confused? So are the rest of us :).
