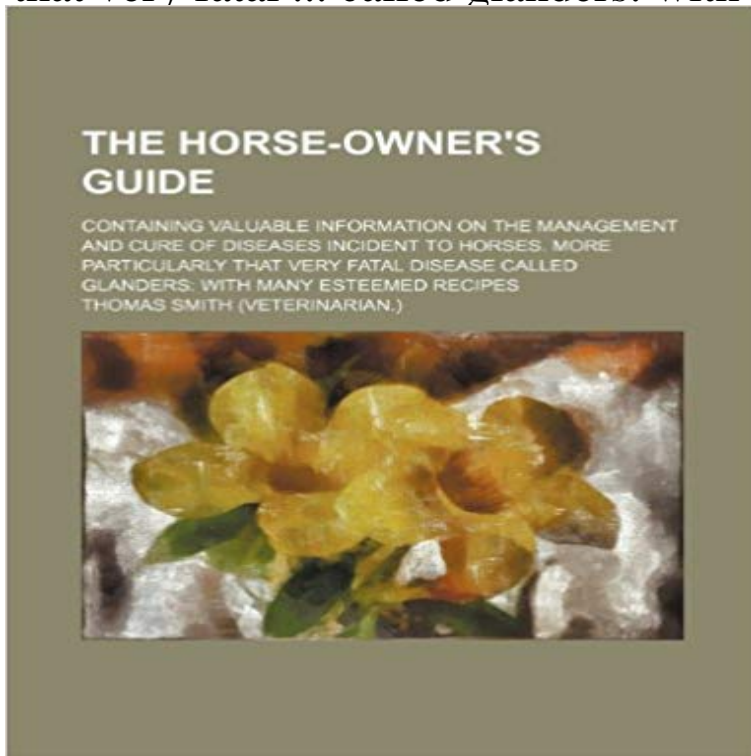

But when a perforation is made in the os frontis, and an injection is employed, however simple it may be, if a large quantity is thrown into the frontal sinuses by a syringe, part of it will be forced into the maxillary sinuses, from which it cannot all escape, and therefore it may do some mischief, and strong injections will be found highly injurious. In those cases, a slight application of the caustic to the diseased part will be found preferable: it is only when the disease is seated in the nostrils, more especially in the inferior extremity of those cavities, that mild injections can be employed with advantage.
