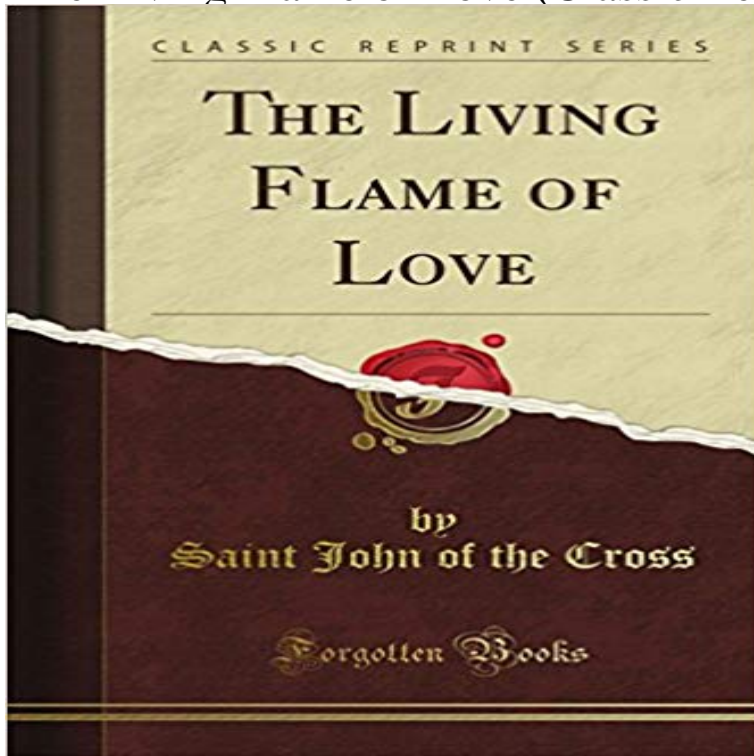


The Living Flame of Love (Classic Reprint)
