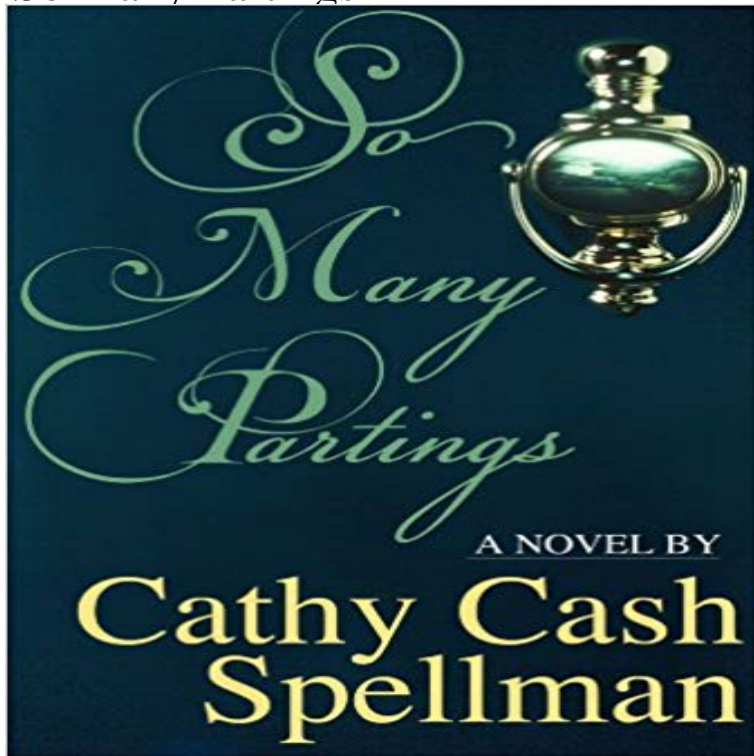


So Many Partings

In a landscape filled with the rich and the poor, the powerful and the powerless, the victors and the victims, *So Many Partings* tells a story about love and betrayal, about a man and the women who shape him: the bewildered mother who abandoned him to save herself the gentle wife who had defied her father to marry the man she loves the shrewd madam who pledges her loyal friendship as well as her love and finally, the high-spirited granddaughter who inherits a greater legacy than wealth. Set against the richness of Irish-American history, *So Many Partings* is about a passionate family and the triumphs and tragedies that make them unforgettable.
