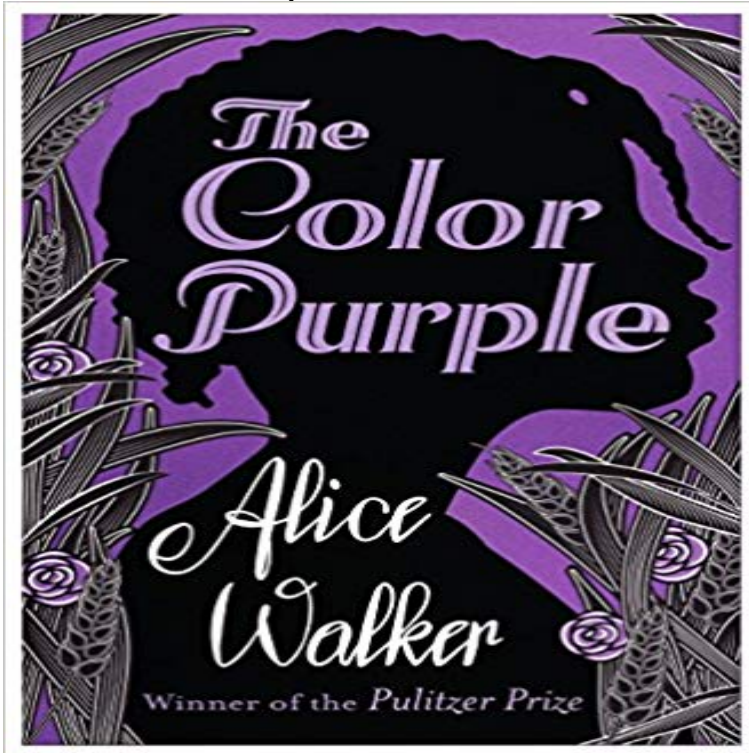


The Color Purple
