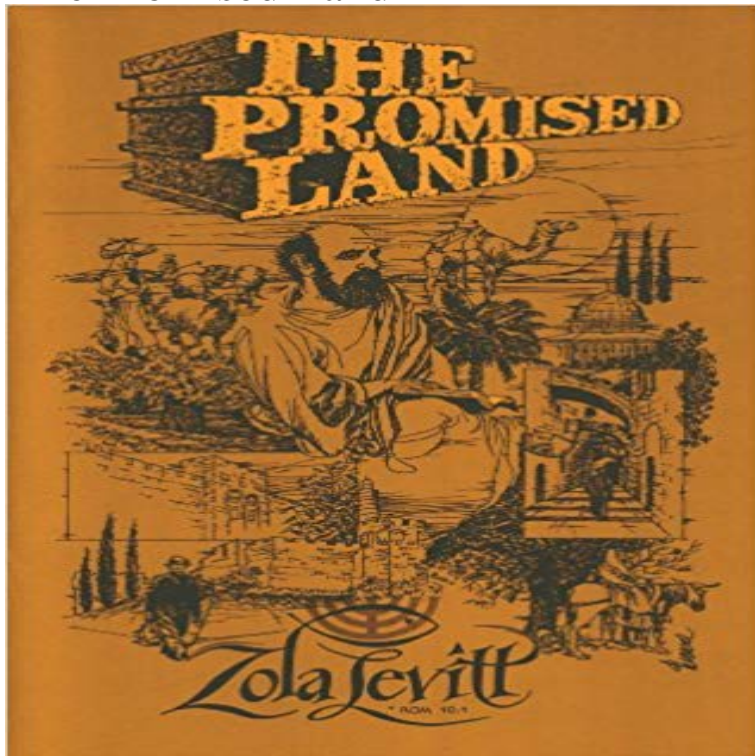


The Promised Land
